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Black Forest break At Villa Stéphanie in

Baden-Baden, author Natalie Livingstone finds herself in detox heaven

VILLA STÉPHANIE IS THE most glamorous grande dame of spas, set on the edge of the Black Forest in Baden-Baden, Queen Victoria's beloved Bavarian holiday spot. The spa sits within the opulent society hotel Brenners Park, which through the centuries has welcomed a series of highprofile guests, including Fyodor Dostoevsky and Barack Obama.

Like them, from the moment I arrived, I was enveloped in the retreat's warm, heavenly scented embrace - albeit, in my case, a lean, gluten- and lactose-free embrace. Villa Stéphanie is a hightech medispa with 15 digital-detox suites, providing every service exacting guests could ask for.

In the connecting mansion, Haus Julius, there's an array of medical treatments on offer, from traditional Chinese medicine to ultra-modern dental surgery. (I just about resisted the urge to come home with a set of gleaming veneers, which would have been ready for me by the time I checked out of the spa.)

Instead, I got with the health programme: there are myriad to choose between, from immunityboosting regimes to weight-loss regimens. What's more, the food is delicious, dare I say decadent: lobster one evening in the serene, tasteful salon, and miraculously, the Michelin-starred kitchen even manages to make cabbage soup seem appealing. Alcohol is off limits, but coffee is available on demand, so there's no fear of getting the caffeine-withdrawal headaches I've come to associate with health retreats.

This is the perfect place for those who wish to unwind without the deprivation de rigueur in many modish medispas. Villa Stéphanie covers 5,000 square metres and is equipped with a pool, gym and hammam. During my massage, healing hands doused me in warm vanilla oil that smelled good enough to drink. Book in advance with legendary therapist Othman Challouf, whose signature treatment - a fusion of deeptissue, shiatsu and Thai massage is life-changing. I'm already dreaming of another pilgrimage to this wellness wonder.
