Then have an Ananné facial (a new, natural yet super hi-tech Swiss skincare range), stroll up the Alpine pastures to the Alm mountain hut for sausage and beer (or opt for a quinoa-based lunch in the spa, if you are feeling that way inclined), and spend the evening listening to world-class musicians. You will be feeling absurdly relaxed within hours of arriving. And after five days?
